

Media Studies Major

2021 STANDARD Application Packet A

Students are encouraged to apply as soon as they are eligible. They have one opportunity to apply as a Standard or Appeal applicant. Standard applicants have satisfied all the application requirements. Appeal applicants have not satisfied all the application requirements and must provide additional documentation with their application. All decisions are final.

Students may submit standard applications from January through April and June through November in 2021. Applications are not accepted in May or December, the last months of each semester. The 2021 STANDARD Application Packet is divided into two packets—packet A and packet B. Packet A contains the Media Studies COVID-19 modified requirement of a 3.0 GPA in prerequisites and relevant courses. Packet B will revert back to the standard application requirement of a 3.2 GPA in prerequisites and relevant courses plus a new requirement of B- or better in Media Studies 10. The unit and semester requirements remain the same in both packets.

**Packet A is for students submitting applications before fall semester 2021 begins (August 17, 2020).
They are due by 11:59 p.m. on the final date of the periods noted below:**

**Tuesday, January 5 – Friday, April 30
Tuesday, June 1 – Tuesday, August 17**

Eligibility

You may apply to Media Studies when you have completed all four prerequisites or have completed three prerequisites, including Media Studies 10, and are enrolled in the fourth prerequisite during the term in which you apply. All prerequisites must be taken for letter grades with the special exception of spring 2020 P grades from any school and fall 2020/spring 2021 P grades from UC Berkeley only. You must take approved courses to satisfy prerequisite requirements. Media Studies does not accept high school exam scores.

Standard Application

The spring 2021 Media Studies application policy has been modified due to the fall 2020 and spring 2021 P grade policy that applies to UC Berkeley courses only. It also applies to summer 2021 Media Studies standard applications. It differs from the fall 2021 major application policy; see Media Studies Standard Application B 2021.

You may submit a standard application if you have met both of the following standard application requirements:

- a GPA of 3.0 in the prerequisites and any course you have taken that satisfies a major course requirement;
- have completed no more than 70 units (excluding high school exam scores, community college courses taken while in high school and excess P.E. units) if you began UC Berkeley as a freshman OR are applying during your first two semesters at UC Berkeley if you are a transfer student.

The major application GPA will be based on the letter grades for courses relevant to the major as noted above. If you have only approved P grades per P grade policies noted on the Media Studies website and it is not possible to calculate an application GPA based on courses relevant to the major, substitute your overall GPA as your major application GPA on the application.

A standard application includes 1) a Media Studies Standard Applicant Information Form – Packet A 2021 and 2) a Major Declaration Form, which needs to be signed by only you before submission; and 3) copies of unofficial transcripts if you took courses to satisfy major requirements at other schools that do not appear on your Transfer Center Report in CalCentral at the time you are applying.

Transferred Coursework

If you satisfied a prerequisite for the major at a California community college, verify that you took the correct prerequisite(s) on assist.org. All other transferred course(s) taken to satisfy Media Studies course requirement(s) must be approved by Dr. Josh Jackson, Assistant Director of Media Studies, prior to applying to the major.
